Test Question	Score
Contains by products (-10)	
For every non-specific meat source (-10)	
Contains BHA, BHT, or ethoxyquin (-10)	
For every non-specific grain source (-5)	
If the same grain ingredient is used 2 or more times in the first five ingredients (-5)	
If the protein sources are not meat meal and there are less than 2 meats in the top 3 ingredients (-3)	
Artificial colorants (-3)	
Ground corn or whole grain corn (-3)	
Corn listed in the top 5 ingredients (-2)	
Contains any animal fat other than fish oil (-2)	
If lamb is the only animal protein source (-2)	
If it contains soy or soybeans (-2)	
If it contains wheat (-2)	
If it contains beef (-1)	
If it contains salt (-1)

<b>Extra Credit:</b>	
If any of the meat sources are organic (+5)	
If the food is endorsed by any major breed group or nutritionist (+5)	
If the food is baked not extruded (+5)	
If the food contains probiotics (+3)	
If the food contains fruit (+3)	
If the food contains vegetables (NOT corn or other grains) (+3)	
If the animal sources are hormone-free and antibiotic-free (+2)	
If the food contains barley (+2)	
If the food contains flax seed oil (not just the seeds) (+2)	
If the food contains oats or oatmeal (+1)	
If the food contains sunflower oil (+1)	
For every different specific animal protein source (+1)	
If it contains glucosamine and chondroitin (+1)	
If the vegetables have been tested for pesticides and are pesticide-free (+1)
